A very lively wine

Harvesting by hand. No fining; very light filtering.

"Le Clos" is a plot surrounded by a wall, located in the park at the front of the domaine. Originally planted as a garden, it now produces a very rich wine with grilled notes and accents of white fruits such as pears. Always very lively, it has a lemony finish that makes it a good candidate for ageing 5–10 years.
