



## MONTHELIE "PIERREFITTE"

*A silky wine*

Harvesting by hand. No fining; very light filtering.

Named for the Dolmens or Menhirs found here, "Pierrefitte" (or "Pièce Fitte") is located near the boundary with Volnay, on the hilltop at an altitude of almost 325 metres. A wine for keeping, it needs several years of ageing to fully express its personality, revealing notes of black fruits and spices with a silky tannin structure. To be cellared for 5–10 years.
